Lynn Schenck was elected as the first female president of SIOR in 2003 after years of invaluable participation on a variety of SIOR committees and task forces. Following her tenure as President, Lynn has continued to remain active as an SIOR leader, serving on the Past Presidents Advisory Council and Professional Standards Committee as well as serving two terms on the SIOR Foundation Board of Trustees. She has received numerous SIOR transaction awards and was named the SIOR Broker of the Year in 1997. On the local level, Lynn has served as President for the SIOR St. Louis Chapter and the St. Louis Association of Realtors Commercial Division as well as being a founding member of Commercial Real Estate Women (CREW) St. Louis. In 2002, she was named as one of the 25 most influential business women by the St. Louis Business Journal and received the St. Louis Associations of REALTORS Realtor of the Year award. In addition to her professional accomplishments, Lynn is also an active volunteer leader in the St. Louis community. In the past she has served on the Board of Directors for The Ronald McDonald House, as a trustee with Kirkwood United Methodist Church, and was the Old Newsboys Day Fabulous 50 Co-Chair. Currently Lynn leads the St. Louis brokerage operations for Jones Lang LaSalle and serves on the grants committee for Ronald McDonald Children's Charities, the board of Nurses for Newborns, the member involvement committee of St. Louis Forum, The Trailnet Leadership Council, the endowment committee for her church and the Real Estate Council of the Federal Reserve Bank of St. Louis.
