Named Scholarship Agreement

The SIOR St. Louis Chapter and the SIOR Foundation Term Scholarship Fund

Donor: Society of Industrial & Office Realtors (000582400)

Society of Industrial & Office Realtors has chosen to create a named term scholarship to benefit students at the John Cook School of Business.

Society of Industrial & Office Realtors does hereby document their intention to make a \$12,000 gift to create a term scholarship. This gift commitment meets the University's current standard of a minimum commitment of \$10,000 to establish a named term scholarship.

The fund is to be administered according to the following provisions:

Purpose / Restrictions:

- **Enrollment status:** *Junior and Senior status*
- **Overall GPA:** *2.5 GPA or higher*
- **Renewable:** *Yes*
- **Application process:** Interested students will supply the Chair of the Finance Department with a one page memo about commercial real estate and their interest in the field, a resume and current transcript.
- **Selection process:** This fund will be administered through the office of Student Financial Services. The Chair of the Finance Department at John Cook School of Business will collect applications for the SIOR St. Louis Chapter and the SIOR Foundation Term Scholarship. A committee including the Chair of the Finance Department, Associate Director of Corporate Relations and Scholarship Coordinator of Giving Programs will determine scholarship recipients. The Scholarship

Coordinator of Giving Programs will forward student recipients to the office of Student Financial Services for administering of the fund.

Scholarship Match Initiative

The SIOR St. Louis Chapter and the SIOR Foundation Scholarship qualifies for Saint Louis University's Go Further Scholarship Initiative. All payments and gifts to this fund of \$100 and more will be matched, dollar for dollar, from the signing of this agreement through the 2016 fiscal year (June 30, 2016).

Contingency


